Enterprises

Enterprises are the main body of execution and implementation of the standardization. Enterprises issue and manage enterprise standards. The enterprise standards are their internal affairs, which is fully managed by enterprises themselves.

Local Standards

Local authorities of standardization administration for all levels of government
Local authorities of standardization administration for all levels of government are responsible for administering standardization work in their respective administrative areas, including constitution of local regulations and policies, development and emending of local standards, and guidance of standardization for enterprises in their region.

Local institutes of standardization
Local institutes of standardization, administrated by the local department of standardization administrations, mainly take on development and revision of local standards for their region.

Industry Standards

Industry institutes of standardization
Industry institutes of standardization, administrated by their industry ministry, mainly take on development and revision of national standards and industry standards for their industry.

Standardization administrations of Ministries
Standardization administrations of ministries are in charge of administration, supervision and coordination of standardization work for their industry. In addition, it is responsible for organization of development of national standards in the related industries, and development, examination, sanction and release of industry standards of departments as well.

China national technical committees of standardization (TC/SC/WG)
China national technical committees of standardization administrated by SAC are in charge of formulation and revision of the national standards and industry standards; undertaking tasks related with Technical Committees of ISO and IEC.

National Standards

China National Institute of Standardization (CNIS)
CNIS, a national institute of standardization, provides technical support and scientific basis for SAC, mainly involved in standardization study on strategic issues of national economy and social development, in addition, as well as development of basic standards and authoritative information services on standards.

Association Standards

Industry standardization associations
Industry standardization associations authorized by SAC, are responsible for developing and issuing association standards and management of standardization work in their industry.

Enterprise Standards

China Association for Standardization (CAS)
CAS, a social organization, is administrated and guided by SAC, mainly engages in organization of standardization activities around China, development and emendation of CAS standards, training of standards and international communication and cooperation on standardization.

Standards Press of China
Standards Press of China is the only officially press authorized by SAC to print and publish national standards and party industry standards.

National Library of Standards
National Library of Standards is the authorized library of collection, store and service for national standards and industry standards.

China National Management System Roadmap of Standards

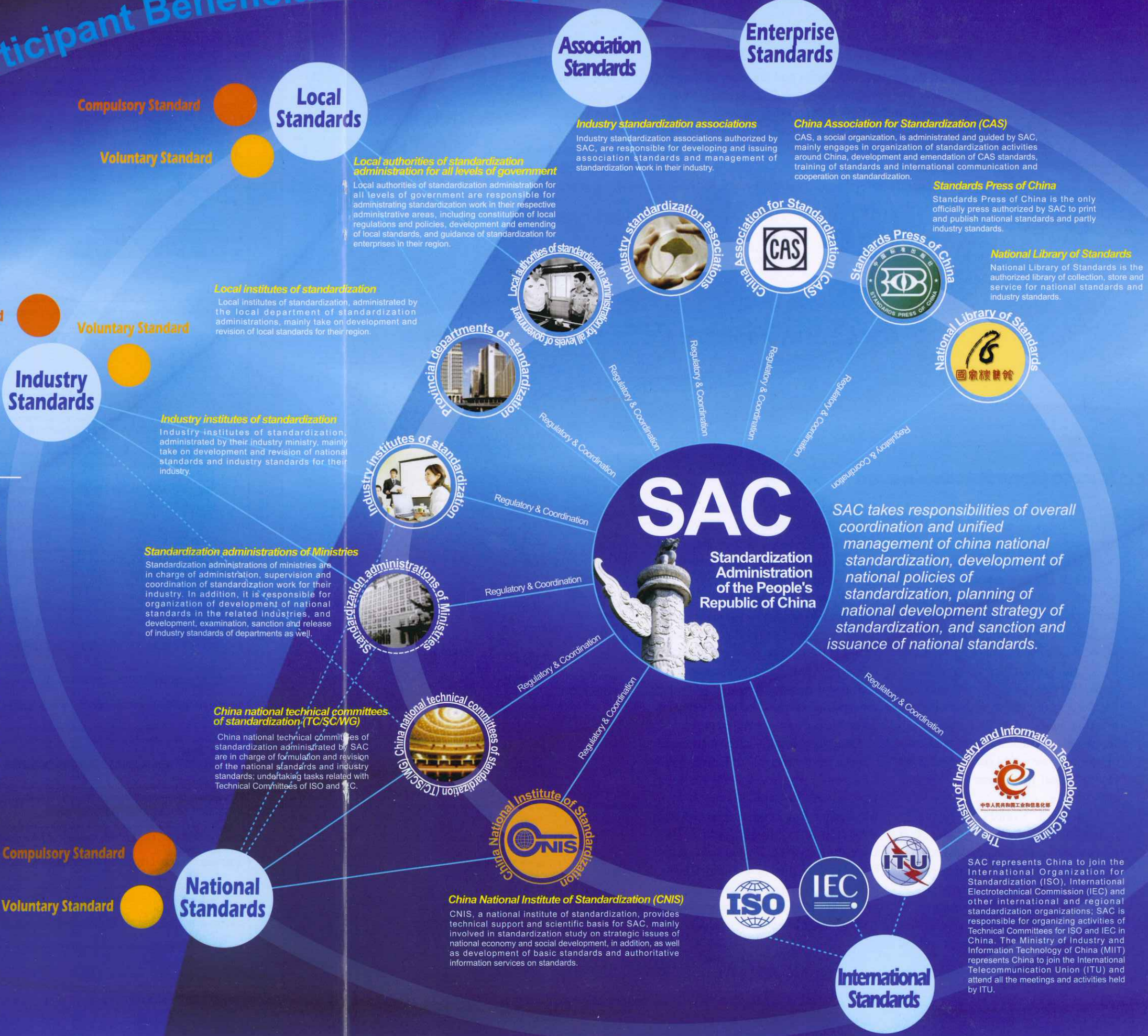
The roadmap indicates the organizational structure and system distribution which involves in development and promotion of standards for China national management system of standards.

China has undertaken 56 TCs and SCs in ISO and IEC for all types of specialty, and developed 478 Technical Committees and 649 Sub-Technical Committees of SAC. So far China has released more than 36926 national standards, about 120,000 industrial standards and 120,000 local standards and about one million enterprise standards; which have made great contribution to economy and social development of China.

SAC

Standardization Administration of the People's Republic of China

SAC takes responsibilities of overall coordination and unified management of china national standardization, development of national policies of standardization, planning of national development strategy of standardization, and sanction and issuance of national standards.



SAC represents China to join the International Organization for Standardization (ISO), International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) and other international and regional standardization organizations; SAC is responsible for organizing activities of Technical Committees for ISO and IEC in China. The Ministry of Industry and Information Technology of China (MIIT) represents China to join the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and attend all the meetings and activities held by ITU.
